POSITION OVERVIEW

The position we offer is Crop Production Manager at the main farm Cocora, where 11,500 ha of crop production is currently cultivated. Wheat, maize, sunflowers, soya, and rapeseed are mainly grown.

Our agricultural practice is done according to the Conservation Agriculture method, with a focus on soil moisture, soil health, minimum disturbance, and adaptation to local climatic conditions.

The Crop Production Manager reports directly to the CEO, and forms part of the management team for crop production together with 2 other Danish managers.

Together, the strategy in crop production is determined. Production plans and management decisions are continuously discussed in the crop production management team. In everyday life, it is the Crop Production manager who independently manages and plans the crop production department together with 2 team leaders and acting co-team leaders.

Planning and servicing and maintenance of the machine park is handled by the service manager.

The organizational structure, the management basis, the system, and the ongoing development of the management team provide the Crop Production Manager with the optimal conditions for good leadership.
